Biography

Taqwa Alnaqbi (b. Khorfakkan UAE, 1994) is an Emirati artist whose works incorporate handmade papers and mixed media. Her works are inspired by personal experiences that come from her surroundings, which she savors and celebrates through her art. In the Grandmother's Dress series, Taqwa incorporated fibers from her grandmother's dresses into the handmade papers process, and embroidered her grandmother's drawings onto the paper with Talli threads as a means to preserve memories of her grandmother and to celebrate the UAE's intangible cultural heritage of embroidery practice.

Taqwa received a Bachelor of Fine Arts at College of Fine Arts and Design in University of Sharjah in 2016 and completed the Salama Emerging Artists Fellowship in 2018.
