Biography

Faris Alshafar (b. 1995, Dubai) is an Emirati artist based between Dubai and New York City. A self-taught artist, Alshafar's practice is informed by music and other time-bound sensory experiences. He perceives memories of these experiences as self-contained universes. Distinct forms and textures from these experiences come into being through rhythmic mark-making and layered abstractions in his paintings and drawings. Glyph-like symbols and gestures coalesce into sonically resonating landscapes and arrangements that evoke and reference sensations themselves. Meditations on determinism and other philosophical facets are woven into the bodies of these works. By evoking the record of his experience both personally and impersonally, he opens flickering channels of perception for the viewer to move through.

His work is held in several notable collections, including the UAE Ministry of Foreign Affairs, the Permanent Mission of the UAE to the United Nations in New York City, the UAE Consulate in New York City and the Abu Dhabi Executive Office. In 2021, during his post-graduate studies, Alshafar curated a three-year major exhibition for the Permanent Mission of the UAE to the UN in collaboration with the Barjeel Art Foundation.

Alshafar holds a Master's in Arts & Cultural Management from Pratt Institute, Brooklyn, New York, USA (2021) and a Bachelor of Business Administration in Marketing from the American University in Dubai, UAE (2017).
